Phase I Handgun Qualification

Clients must demonstrate:

- Safe Gun Handling
- Safe Line - Understanding Range Commands
- Safe **Muzzle** Direction - Keep muzzle pointed in a safe direction at all times; Straight downrange, at backstop, berm or targets. Never point muzzle at any part of your own body or at fellow shooters on the firing line.
- Safe **Finger** Position – Keep finger(s) VISIBLY outside of TRIGGER GUARD at all times – unless engaging a target.
- Loading Gun – Safely and deliberately load gun (be aware of finger and muzzle). Never be in a hurry to load your gun on the line. Safe or de-cock your gun immediately after loading (if applicable)
- Holstering – Holster gun slowly, deliberately and AFTER gun is safe / de-cocked (if applicable), and taking one breath. Never be in a hurry to holster your gun.
- Presentation – Drawing from holster to target (be aware of finger and muzzle).
- Reload – Demonstrate dropping and retaining magazine and inserting new magazine (be aware of finger and muzzle).
- Unloading Gun – Safely and deliberately unload gun (be aware of finger and muzzle). Never be in a hurry to unload your gun. Visually inspect that your gun is unloaded (3-point check) and show the RO or shooter next to you before holstering.
- Unloaded Gun Condition
 - Empty Chamber
 - No Magazine Inserted
 - Slide Forward
 - Hammer or Striker DOWN (via pressing the trigger / not by decocking).

Phase I Handgun Qualification

Clients must pass Phase I Qualification:

All strings are shot from the **holster** (with or without cover garment).
Gun is **loaded**, with **safety** on / **de-cocked** (if applicable) at the start of every string.

Scoring: Round must be inside “A”-box target area or clearly breaking the “A” line for no penalty.

Penalties for round placement outside “A”-box:

- 1 Second added to time - Each B” or “C” zones
- 2 Seconds added to time – Each “D” zone
- 5 Seconds added to time – Each missed shot

Passing Score: Total time (including penalties) of 60 seconds or less.

Students unable to demonstrate safe gun handling or pass Phase I Qualification will be disqualified from the program of instruction, and no refund will be issued.
